Just one death is too many if it is that of one of your relatives or friends, and our deep sympathy is with all such people. But with thoughts such as these that I try to keep a sense of proportion. May God grant us deliverance from this awful pandemic, and allow us to feel joy at the sight of daffodil shoots and fresh snowdrops in the garden.

I don't suppose St Paul got many approving listeners to <u>his</u> message, for married people, saying they should behave as if they were not married, but he is clear that everyone should give undivided attention to the Lord.
