Hello again. As I write there is a deluge outside, so it must be school holidays still. We hope everyone concerned had a restful break. Thanks to the parents who registered their children for First Holy Communion. There are now seven. You will be contacted about arrangements for lessons, sharing that privilege of continuing to introduce your child to Jesus. We will do all we can to help you.

This weekend is the happy celebration of All Saints – not just our patron saints or the more famous ones, but all those souls judged by God to be enjoying heaven in everlasting bliss. We praise and bless them all. In the book of Revelation we read of John's vision of those who suffered martyrdom: a huge number, impossible to count, of people from every nation, race, tribe, and language. In John's first letter, he says we are children of God, and in the future we shall be like Him. The gospel from the Sermon on the Mount lists the kind of people, the pure, the peacemakers, the gentle, the merciful, etc. whose reward will be great in heaven.

On **Tuesday** we commemorate all those preparing to enter heaven, the Holy Souls. We will try to remember the names of all those whose funerals have taken place in the last two years, pay tribute to them for their faith and holiness, and commend their souls to God's mercy. There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament here at St Winefride's on Tuesday at 7.00pm followed by a **Memorial Mass at 7.30pm**.
