TUESDAY'S FEAST celebrates three English martyrs who were women. We can only marvel at their faith and their courage. MARGARET CLITHEROW lived in York. She married early and became a Catholic at 18. She gave lessons in RE to children and let visiting priests stay at her house. This was an offence punishable by death. She was crushed to death in 1586. MARGARET WARD was born in Congleton. Working in service in London, she helped a priest to escape from prison and was found out. She was executed in 1588. ANNE LINE's husband was exiled to Spain for attending Mass. Anne had Mass at her house but one day it was noticed that many people were coming, and they were discovered. Anne was imprisoned and hanged in 1601. Mass meant rather a lot to these brave women. What does it mean to you and me?
