READINGS AT MASS The prophet Habakkuk, living through the hard time when Nebuchadnezzar emperor of the Chaldeans was destroying the kingdoms of Israel and Judah, asks God why he uses a bad ruler to punish God's chosen people. The answer comes: If the upright people trust in God, they will survive. The gospel story suggests that having faith can well be a dogged business, a hard slog with little obvious relief. Paul tells Timothy that he has the Spirit, the Spirit of power and love and self-control, and with this gift he can be as brave as the imprisoned Paul.

During the month of October, we could maybe pray the rosary each day for world peace, asking Our Lady's powerful intercession. Friday is a feast in honour of Our Lady of the Rosary. Wednesday is in honour of the Divine Mercy visionary, the Polish Sister Faustina, baptised Helena Kowalska.

Please note that there IS a Mass on Monday; and because of the funeral Mass on Tuesday there will NOT be an evening Mass or Exposition. .
