CORPUS CHRISTI Today we honour Jesus and his plan to enable us to be united with him as he offered himself to the Father in a sacrificial meal. He unites himself with us in this unique way by becoming food, which we assimilate, and since he is the greater, we become part of him. The feast gives us the opportunity to make reparation for all the insults and blasphemies made to the Real Presence in the Eucharist.

Bishop John Fisher and Chancellor Thomas More were such brave and lonely martyrs put to death for refusing to take the oath of supremacy in 1535.
