READINGS AT MASS St Paul spent a lot of time in prison, and was able to see the unpleasantness of gaol as suffering, which he can bear on behalf of others. **Leprosy** was a common fatal illness in Jesus' time and earlier. Naaman the Syrian general was healed of the disease after following instructions from the Hebrew prophet Elisha. Jesus healed ten lepers but only one said 'Thank you'. For obvious reasons, sin has been seen as like a kind of horrible disfiguring illness. Jesus can cure us sinners, and heals us when we ask his forgiveness, and it is good manners at least to say thank you and to show our gratitude by changing our way of life.

During the month of October, we could maybe pray the rosary each day for world peace, asking Our Lady's powerful intercession.
